
Donations of canned goods, toiletries and new undergarments for men and women will be accepted at the new Veterans medical center at 2400 Canal Street from 8 to 10 a.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays from October 3 - 19, 2017.

For quick drop-off, a drive thru is set up on the Rocheblave side of the campus, just passed the Urgent Care parking lot, for donors to quickly drive through and drop off their donations.

Any donors wishing to make donations outside of the drive thru donation hours can make arrangements by calling the SLVHCS Voluntary Service at 504-507-2033.

Donations will be dispersed to homeless Veterans at the annual Stand Down for Homeless Veterans scheduled for October 28, 2017 at the new Veterans medical center, where SLVHCS, along with an array of community partners and volunteers, will come together to provide food, clothing, employment and health resources to homeless Veterans throughout the region.
