Drive thru flu shots for Veterans

NEW ORLEANS – Southeast Louisiana Veterans Health Care System will be offering drive thru influenza vaccines for Veterans at the new Veterans medical center and several of its community based outpatient clinics Saturday, Dec. 17, from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. Veterans can go to the main entrance to receive flu shots at the clinics in Hammond, Baton Rouge North, Slidell and St John as well as the patient parking garage of the new Veterans medical center on South Galvez Street in New Orleans.

“Providing our Veterans with access to high quality health care is our top priority and these drive thru flu clinics are another way of doing that,” SLVHCS Medical Center Director Fernando O. Rivera, FACHE said. “It’s very important during flu season that we help Veterans and their families stay protected.”

The flu shot is also available to Veterans during their scheduled appointments and walk-ins are welcome at all primary care clinics from 9 to 11 a.m. and 1 to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday except on federal holidays.
