VA hosts town hall meeting for Veterans

NEW ORLEANS – The Department of Veterans Affairs will hold a town hall meeting at 6 p.m., Jan. 29 at the Lake Vista Community Center, 6500 Spanish Fort Blvd., New Orleans, Louisiana.

The event will be a joint town hall with the Southeast Louisiana Veterans Health Care System and Veterans Benefits Administration.
